The issue is the checkbox on the right side of the page (bottom snippet). The screen shots are available at

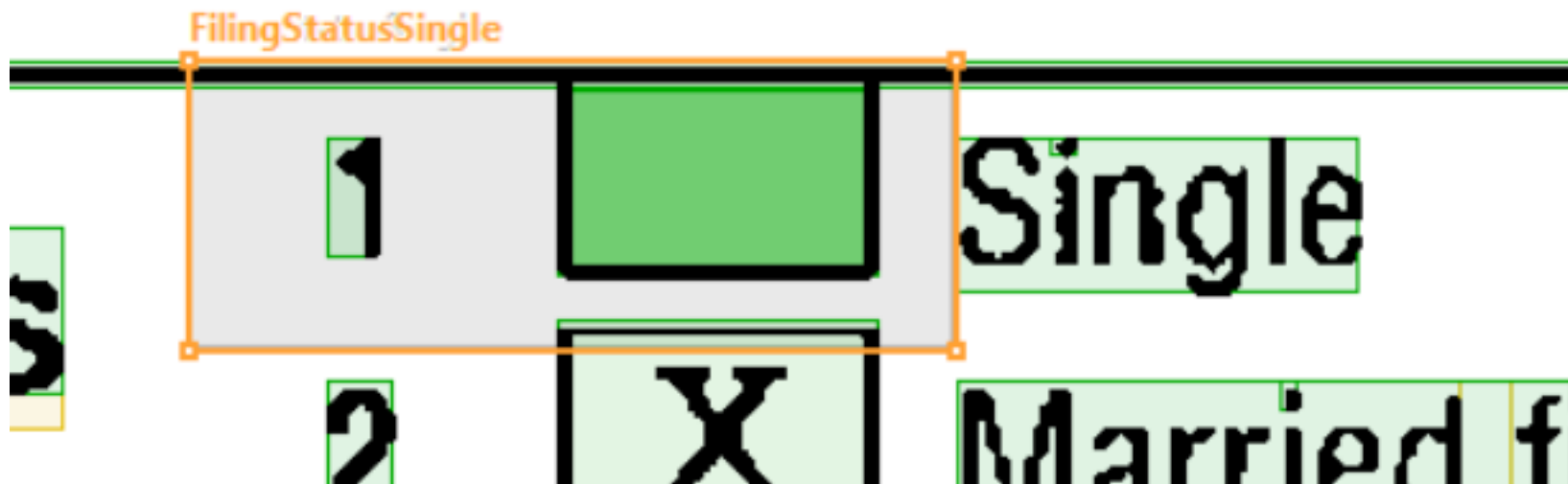

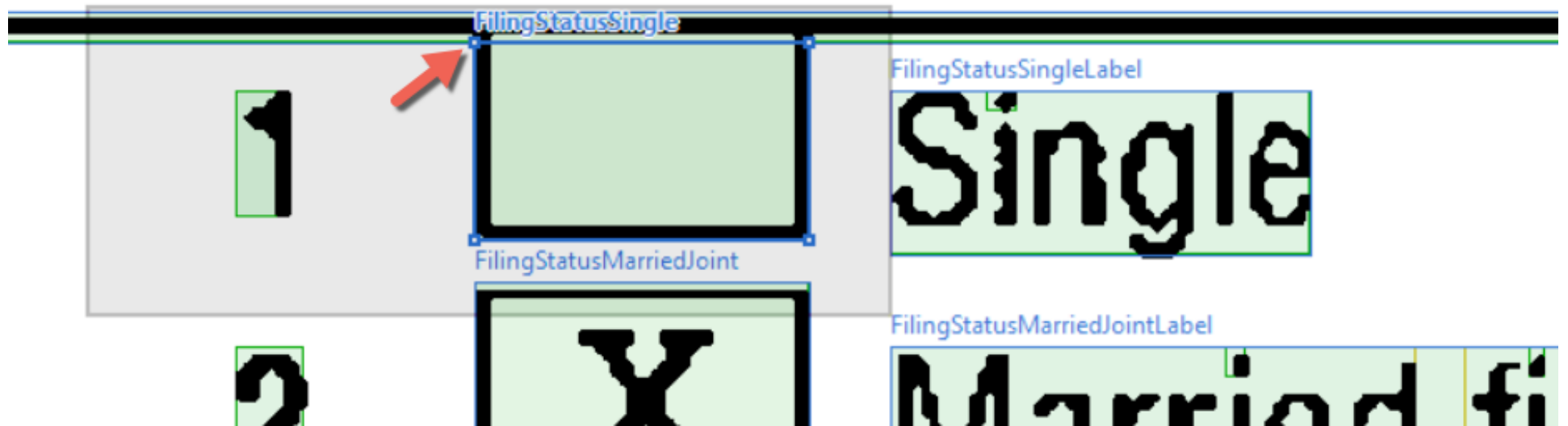
Are there any FlexiLayout Language commands that will allow FLS to recognize a checkbox attached to a horizontal line?
