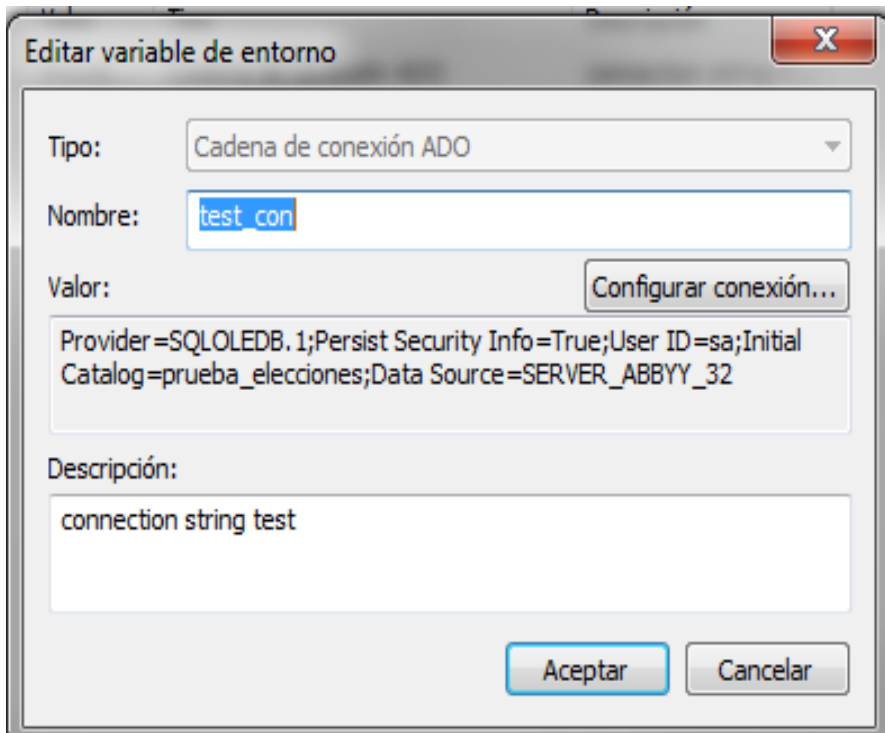


CREATING THE ENVIRONMENT VARIABLE (DATASOURCE CONNECTION ADO)
